Celebrations are double-fold this month, as we were thrilled to receive confirmation of our successful re-designation as your Teaching School Hub.

For three years, we have been honoured to represent, support, advocate and celebrate you and the fantastic work you do across Sheffield and Rotherham. We are your Teaching School Hub and have seen many successes over our previous tenure. We cannot wait to see what the future holds as we move forward together.

We have welcomed 452 ITT/ITE trainees into our profession through our <u>STTA</u> and <u>NML</u> SCITT provision.

We have delivered our ECF programme on behalf of Education Development Trust to 717 ECTs.

We have provided statutory support to 1,295 ECTs through our <u>Appropriate Body</u> service.

We have supported 531 NPQ participants across the entire NPQ suite.

We have collaborated with education partners and providers across our region.

We have worked with 288 schools across our region and 249 schools nationally.



#### TRAINEE HIGHLIGHTS

## Initial Teacher Training (ITT)

There are lots of things happening in the wonderful world of Initial Teacher Education (ITE) this year so here are the highlights to support you in your roles.

- Whilst nationally, recruitment of potential trainees for 2024/25 has been hampered, locally recruitment has been positive.
- The new <u>Initial Teacher Training and Early Career Framework</u> (ITTECF) for 2025 is a welcome addition to the landscape and will support all stakeholders with their developing skills and practice.
- Our regional ITE providers have come together to support school and mentor capacity following the market review which will come into effect in September 2024. Our regional commitment will support all stakeholders and will be shared later this term.
- Our ITT scoping work is going tremendously well, encompassing over half our region's schools.

### Early Career Teacher (ECT)

Our ECTs are blossoming in their Early Career Framework (ECF) programme and their application of learning to their pedagogy and practice. Feedback from Mentor, Induction Tutor and ECT colleagues from our in-person sessions and their online learning has been phenomenal and it has been wonderful to hear news from our previous cohorts as they take the next steps in their careers. With 90% retention of ECTs in our region's schools and on our ECF programme, it is amazing to see the impact they are having on the education of our young people.

#### NPQ SUCCESSES

So far our NPQ community consists of:

- 723 participants
- 283 schools

#### We have seen:

- 98% retention rate across all programmes.
- 99% pass rate across all programmes.
- Participants from cohorts 1-3 who have been promoted and are taking the next steps in their careers.
- New facilitators were identified and trained to support future cohorts.

Our Cohort 4 specialist participants have submitted their assessments and we await their results with much anticipation. We look forward to seeing all our participants continue to develop their pedagogy, practice and leadership in our region's schools.
