Registration process for schools – registering ECTs and mentors

We are expecting the next stage of the registration process for schools on the DfE's digital service to start sometime in June – but currently there is no set date, so please be aware that schools are not yet able to register individual ECTs and mentors.

As you know, all schools need to register both through Education Development Trust's landing page, - <https://www.educationdevelopmenttrust.com/ecf> and through the DfE's digital service.
